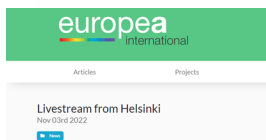
## SUCCESSFUL STUDENT ACTIVITY IN HELSINKI!

**In October 2022 29 students and 10 teachers worked during one week at “Distant Learning and Coaching” with a livestream about radiology, from the Taitotalo school in Helsinki Finland.**

Previously, students worked at the theory of this subject with the digital platform Moodle. Students could test themselves with questions and quizzes. After a morning of getting to know each other, students followed a short lecture of the theory of radiology. With this basic knowledge students started with their task: make a tutorial with demonstration of different positioning for radiology of pet animals, for a livestream at the next day. Students were very motivated and worked enthusiastically at the task.

The livestream was shown in different countries, with different students and colleagues, and some associated partners of the project. With their feedback, and that of the participating students, the products for Distant Coaching and Learning, and Work Based Learning, will be improved. Students also had a cultural day, where they visited the city centre of Helsinki. One group of students even travelled to a national park, trying to see the northern light.

It was heart warming to see students exchange phonenumber at the end of the week. The sentence “We will keep in touch”, was heard in several groups. We conclude it was a very useful week, with great experiences for the project, and great personal developments!



## X-RAY YOGA; DISTANT LEARNING A PILOT.

**During the student activity in Helsinki, the Finnish teacher on radiology suggested to do a continuation of the lessons radiology and explore if this instruction could be done from a distance. So last November, we organized an extra pilot.**

All the way from Finland, a teacher taught some theory about safety procedures. She used a livestream. And additionally, students performed a practical task using the livestream. The Finnish teacher coached the students in The Netherland during their practical task.

Students were taught to look away when making the X-ray, but to keep an eye on the breathing frequency of the animal in the meantime. The combination of large movements, adjusted to the breathing of the animal, lead to the unforgettable words “X-ray Yoga”.... Student will not forget this part very quickly....
